

A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION

A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF FORGET IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO ESTABLISH A MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION.


**Whereas** the Council of the Village of Forget is responsible for the direction and control of its emergency response and is required, under the Emergency Planning Act of Saskatchewan to establish an Emergency Measures Organization, appoint an Emergency Measures Co-ordinator and establish a municipal Emergency Plan.

**And Whereas** it is desirable in the public interest, and in the interest of public safety, that such a committee be appointed and such an agency be established and maintained to carry out Council's statutory powers and obligations under the Emergency Planning Act of Saskatchewan:

NOW, THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF FORGET DULY ASSEMBLED, ENACTS THE FOLLOWING:

1. That the Council shall establish an Emergency Measures Organization to manage the agencies responding to any emergency or disaster that may occur.
2. The Emergency Measures Organization shall consist of two Branches:
  - a. The Control Committee which shall consist of two or more members appointed by resolution of council. This committee shall establish policy for the Emergency Measures Organization.
  - b. The Planning Committee shall consist of officers of the Village of Forget and such other as deemed necessary. The Planning Committee, under the chairmanship of the co-ordinator shall formulate the Emergency Plan.
3. The Village of Forget shall provide funding as deemed necessary and appropriate in the establishment and maintenance of the Emergency Measures Organization.
4. The council may co-operate with Councils of other municipalities for the purpose of jointly establishing a Mutual Aid Area.


