

**BYLAW No. 3-07**

**A BYLAW of the VILLAGE OF FORGET, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN**


**TO PREVENT THE OBSTRUCTION OF ROADS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES BY VEHICLES OR OTHER ARTICLES OR THINGS.**

The Council of the Village of Forget, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall encumber or obstruct any highway, street or lane in the Village by leaving a vehicle, building, other article or thing standing thereon.
2. Any person found guilty of a breach of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Village.


