

VILLAGE of FORGET
BY-LAW No. 1-12

A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE
OF DOMESTICATED ANIMALS

The Council of the Village of Forget in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. For the purpose of this by-law the expression:
 - (a) "domesticated animal" shall mean all dogs, cats and all other animals owned by any other person.
 - (b) "Municipality" shall mean the Village of Forget".
 - (c) "Running at Large" shall mean when the domesticated animal is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor or harbourer of the said domesticated animal, or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may be with the permission of the owner or occupant of the said land or is not accompanied by or in direct control of the owner, possessor or harbourer.
2. No domesticated animal shall run at large in the Municipality.
3. A person who owns, possesses or harbours a domesticated animal found running at large shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this by-law.
4. Any person may take any domesticated animal found running at large contrary to the provisions of this by-law to the municipal pound where it shall be kept for 3 days unless the owner, possessor or harbourer redeems the domesticated animal by paying the administrator the sum of
\$20.00 for each day impounded and the sum of
\$ 5.00 per day for the care and keep
of each domesticated animal.
5.
 - (a) The Village of Forget may sell any domesticated animal which is not redeemed within 3 days.
 - (b) The Village of Forget or at their request, any other person, may destroy any domesticated animal which has not been redeemed within 4 days.


By-Law No. 1-12 – Regulate Running at large *Domesticated Animals* (continued)

- 6. (a) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of Section 3 of this by-law, shall be guilty of an offense and liable:
 - (i) Upon the first conviction of a fine of not more than \$25.00;
 - (ii) Upon the second conviction of a fine of not more than \$50.00;
 - (iii) Upon the third conviction of a fine of not more than \$75.00;
 - (iv) Upon the fourth conviction of a fine of not less than \$100.00 and not greater than \$2,000.00 and the destruction of the domesticated animal at the discretion of the Council of the Village of Forget.
- (b) No domesticated animal shall be released until all fines and impoundment fees have been paid by the owner, possessor or harbourer of the domesticated animal to the administrator of the Village of Forget.
- (c) A violator of this by-law, upon being served with a Notice of Violation, may during the office hours voluntarily pay the penalty at the Municipal Office and upon payment as so provided, that person shall not be liable to prosecution of the offence.
- (d) The Notice of Violation shall be In the Form "1" attached to and forming part of this by-law.

7. This bylaw hereby repeals Bylaw No. 2-07.


